Transportation Camp Revs Up Young Learners

CMMM hosted two transportation camps this summer in partnership with White Earth Tribal & Community College (WETCC) and North Dakota State University (NDSU). The first camp featured hands-on activities developed by UMD faculty and WETCC partners, introducing participants to concepts such as polarity, energy systems, and environmental engineering while exploring the local impacts of transportation and fossil fuels. During the second camp, attendees built and programmed robotic cars to learn core engineering and robotics skills.

Led by WETCC faculty member Allen Derks, along with UMD faculty including Cinzia Cirillo, Alba Torrents, and Terry Yang, and NDSU collaborators like Pan Lu, both camps offered meaningful, interactive learning experiences aimed at inspiring the next generation of transportation and science leaders.
