Ph.D. students working on transportation related research are invited to apply to the 2024 MTI fellowship initiative. The fellowship supports one semester GRA and State of MD health benefits, tuition remission should be covered by the student advisor. We anticipate offering five fellowships. The fellowships aim to enhance multi-disciplinary collaboration. The student mentor should be affiliated to MTI or become an affiliate member of MTI.

A complete nomination package must include: 1) This nomination cover sheet; 2) the student proposal (no more than three pages, Times New Roman, 12pt); 3) a letter of recommendation from the student's advisor; and 4) the student's cv (no more than two pages).

The proposal should include:

1. Abstract
2. Problem Statement
3. Methodology
4. Expected Results and Contributions
5. Multi-disciplinary collaboration
6. Benefits and Impact to the student's research

The student must prepare the nomination package as a single PDF file. **Deadline is 5.00 PM, Thursday, February 15, 2024.**
